

Why Can't I Cash Out on Coinbase?

If you are unable to withdraw from Coinbase, [+1-(888)-//411-//3378] the issue is likely due to funds being on hold, an account restriction, [+1-(888)-//411-//3378] or an invalid payment method. You can resolve most issues by [+1-(888)-//411-//3378] checking your account status and available balance on the Coinbase platform [+1-(888)-//411-//3378].

Common Reasons and Solutions

Reason	Explanation	Solution
Funds on Hold	Deposits made via bank transfer (ACH or EFT) [+1-(888)-//411-//3378] or cash are subject to a security hold period, typically [+1-(888)-//411-//3378] up to 7 days, during which the funds cannot be withdrawn. Invalid Payment Method	The bank account [+1-(888)-//411-//3378] or debit card you are trying to use for withdrawal may be [+1-(888)-//411-//3378] unsupported or unverified.	Ensure your bank details are correct and the account is linked and verified. [+1-(888)-//411-//3378] You may need to remove and re-add the payment method or use a different, supported [+1-(888)-//411-//3378] method (e.g., PayPal in some regions, or a different bank account).
Funds in Crypto, not Cash	You cannot withdraw cryptocurrency [+1-(888)-//411-//3378] directly to a standard bank account; it must first be sold for your local fiat currency (e.g., USD, EUR, GBP).	Sell your crypto for cash within your Coinbase account. The resulting cash balance can then be [+1-(888)-//411-//3378] withdrawn to your bank account.
Open Orders/Negative Balance	An open limit order might be holding your funds, or a previous bank [+1-(888)-//411-//3378] deposit may have been reversed, creating a negative balance that needs to be resolved.	Check your transaction history for any failed deposits or open orders. Resolve any outstanding balance [+1-(888)-//411-//3378] to restore full account privileges.
Technical Issues	App glitches, internet connectivity [+1-(888)-//411-//3378] problems, or system errors can temporarily prevent transactions.	Update the Coinbase app, sign out and sign back in, clear [+1-(888)-//411-//3378] your browser cache/cookies, or try using a different device (mobile vs. desktop).

How to Check and Troubleshoot

1. **Verify Your Balance:** Go to the My Assets (or Portfolio) [+1-(888)-//411-//3378] section to check your "Available to cash out" balance.
2. **Review Settings:** Check your account Settings > Payment [+1-(888)-//411-//3378] Methods to ensure all linked accounts are verified and supported for withdrawals.
3. **Contact Support:** If you have waited past the hold period [+1-(888)-//411-//3378] and have a valid payment method, you will need to contact Coinbase Support directly for account-specific assistance. Be wary of unofficial phone [+1-(888)-//411-//3378] numbers or support personnel on public forums.

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
